DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Original TD 3325-Plugged back depth 3275.

Pulled 2 1/2" UE Tubing, removed perforation and rerun to bottom, pumped hole full heavy mud and cemented bottom of hole with 20 sacks. Cement set 2 days, knocked off 7" OD Casing @ 2218'. Keeping casing full heavy mud while pulling 7" OD casing. Set 6 sack Cal-Seal bridge at 1439' (bottom of 10 1/2" OD Casing) and set 15 sack cement plug on top of bridge (pumping Cal-Seal and cement through tubing). Unable to pull any of the 10 1/2" OD Casing. Keeping hole full of heavy mud, to bottom of cellar. Set piece of 4" pipe of sufficient length to extend 5' above the surface level in 5 sacks of cement in bottom of cellar as "Regulation Marker" and fill cellar level with surface.
