

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was originally drilled to a T. D. of 3317' in 1934 with 7" casing set at 3280' and cemented with 100 sacks and 9 5/8" casing set at 2745' and cemented with 300 sacks. Surface pipe (12 1/2") was run to 500' and cemented with 100 sacks. The well has produced until it currently makes 100% water. In an attempt to shut water off, the well was plugged back by stages to 3088' and perforating the casing with no success in shutting off water. Each perforated section was shut off by squeezing cement below a retainer set above the perforations and when there was no show of oil or gas a bridging plug was run to 3088' and 40 sacks of cement dumped on top of the plug.

The well was P & A as follows: Tubing run to bottom, hole mudded with 10# mud and 20 sacks of cement dumped in on top of bottom hole plug already in well. Seven (7") casing was then shot off at 2739' and reclaimed, and 9 5/8" casing shot off at 1697' and reclaimed. A cement plug (20 sacks) was then put in well as 1600' and the 12 1/2" casing then cemented inside from 300' to the surface the 12 1/2" having been cemented at 500' and left in hole. A marker of 4" pipe 4' above the ground was left at the abandoned location.
