### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pumped 20 tons of mud in hole with 25 sacks of ~~Trinity~~ **Trinity** Portland Cement on top.  
 Plugged 7" casing from 2900 to 2150 with 55 sacks Trinity-Portland cement.  
 Shot 7" casing, recovering 2047' 8", left 1266' 4" in hole.  
 Plugged 7" and 9-5/8" casing from 2150 to 2050 with 55 sacks Trinity Portland Cement  
 Shot and recovered 1479' of 9-5/8", leaving 1353' 1" in hole.  
 Pumped 5 tons of mud in hole.  
 Plugged top of 12-1/2" surface casing with 20 sacks of Trinity Portland Cement. 452' 6"  
 of 12-1/2" left in hole. None recovered. Regulation marker set.  
 One joint of 6" line pipe set in surface cement plug for marker.  
 Finished plugging August 29, 1935.
