NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector.

It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon ^{"A"} ~~McJannet~~ Lindley Well No. 3
in ~~W/2 of SW/4~~ of Sec. ~~25~~ 13, Twp. ~~14-25~~, Rge. ~~36-2~~, N. M. P. M., ~~Jul~~
Oil Field, ~~Law~~ County. We plan to commence work on August 10th
1935.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Well has ceased producing oil and is unprofitable to attempt to recondition for gas well.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

The well is capable of producing 300 barrels of
sulphur water per day - No oil or gas

The work we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Fill the hole with mud. Shoot off 7" casing below 9", pull same out of hole.

Run tubing and cement bottom of hole back into 9" csg., at which time the hole will be filled with heavy mud and 9" casing shot and all recovered that is possible. Cement plugs to be placed in well to comply with plugging requirements of the State of New Mexico.
