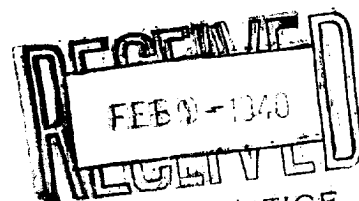

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 2966. Dec. 26th. Plugged back in 7" OD Casing with 18 sacks to Approx. 2850' Jan. 16th, filled hole with heavy mud shot off 7" OD Casing @ 1822 Ft and pulled keeping hole full mud to bottom of cellar. Temporary shut down.

Feb. 5th, set 15 sack cement plug @ 1810' top of shot off 7" OD Casing, shot off 10 3/4" OD casing @ 20 feet and pulled, set 10 sack cement plug in top of shot off 10 3/4" OD Casing keeping hole full heavy mud to bottom of cellar. Set a piece of 4" pipe of sufficient length to extend 4' above the surface level in 5 sacks cement in bottom of cellar as "Regulation Marker" and filled cellar. Well completely Plugged.

Used 12 tons mud

All cement plugs through tubing.
