Regarding the Casing program for the Repollo
Oil Company Stephens well No. 1 at Jal which you called
be about yesterday.

I went to Roswell and discussed this case
with Mr. Taylor and after getting his views on this pro-
posed program I felt we could safely approve their re-
quest upon the condition that they would assume all of
the responsibility and should it become necessary to
make any changes they will do so.

I will take care to see that they take no
unnecessary chances, which I don't think they will
and I believe the program will work. I am enclosing
a copy of my wire to them which is self explanatory.

You will probably note that I addressed the
wire to the Sinclair prairie instead of Repollo oil.
The reason for this; I have had wires and mail returned
which was addressed to the Repollo as they do not
operate under that name in Texas and I am sure it
will reach them addressed to Sinclair prairie.
