DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well treated August 5th, 1935 with 1500 gallons acid solution and 25 bbl. load of oil by Dowell Incorporated, Midland, Michigan.

Formation treated:- Line 3280' to 3330'

Casing:- 7" O.D. set at 3270 w/250 sacks cement.

Well tested:- Pulled swab once at 1665' and once at 2000' and well started flowing; flowed 15 bbls. oil first 15 minutes; 12 bbls. oil second 15 minutes; 11 bbls. oil third 15 minutes and 3/4 bbl. oil last fifteen minutes; well died when Hammon offset well on West opened up.; shows 94% water.
