DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled 1300' of 3" tubing. Ran 3400' of 2" tubing. Mixed and ran 15 tons of mud. Pulled tubing and filled well from 3438' to 3050' with 4 yards pea gravel. Re-ran tubing and established circulation. Plugged back from 3100' to 2675' with 125 sacks El Toro cement. Shot 8-5/8" casing at 2600', 2400', 2200', 2000', 1800', and 1600'. Recovered 1484' of 8-5/8" casing, leaving 1484' in hole. Could not pull 12-1/2" casing, leaving 475' in hole. Filled hole with mud-laden fluid to 12-1/2" casing seat at 475'. Plugged off 12-1/2" csg. with 25 sack El Toro cement from 475' to 445'. Filled balance of hold to top with mud laden fluid. Top of 12-1/2" casing and regulation marker cemented with 25 sacks El Toro cement. (Work performed by Lea County Casing Pullers, Hobbs, New Mexico.
