NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate. Following the completion of the plugging a report should be made under "Report on Result of Abandonment of Well" on Form SG-106.

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon J. A. Koonce Well  
No. 1 in N/2 of Sec. 14 T. 25 South, R. 36 East  
N. M. P. M., Jal Oil Field, Lea County.

We plan to commence work on October 1st, 1935.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Well producing from two to three barrels daily, unprofitable to operate. Has been reconditioned several times without success.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

The well is capable of producing from two to three barrels daily, also makes approximately 200 barrels of water per day. Gas-oil Ratio approximately 286,000 cubic feet to one.

DUPLICATE

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Cement hole back into 7", fill hole with mud, shoot off 7" casing above the Brown Line and recover as much as possible, run tubing and cement bottom of hole back into 10" casing. The 10" will be shot, and recover as much as possible, cement plugs to be placed in well, also, marker in line with plugging requirements of the State of New Mexico.

cement plugs to be placed in well, also, marker in line with plugging reductants  
of the State of New Mexico.
