DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with telephone conversation Mr. Alfred Gooley with Goco Drilling Company, Inc. (Contractors who drilled well) had with Mr. Kleeman of USGS on June 8th, 1959, well was plugged as follows:
Set cement plug 3578' to 3530' (15 sacks cement) Mud to 605'; cement plug 605' to 565' (20 sacks cement). Pulled all 10 3/4" casing. Permission was granted Mr. Sam Beckham (Rancher owner) to keep hole for water well.
Location cleaned up, pits filled, and regulation marker set 10' North of hole.

Turned over to Mr. Sam Beckham, grazing lease, for later completion as a water well.
I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be conducted.
