Re: Reclassification of Humble Oil & Refining Company Grace B. Hadfield No. 1, NW/4 of the SE/4, Section 21, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By letter dated August 9, 1935, from Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr., we were notified that their records indicated that the above captioned well was producing from the horizontal and vertical limits of the Joint Pool and since the gas-oil ratio exceeded 100,000 to 1, that we should make application to this office for a non-standard gas prevention unit so that the well might be operated as a Joint Gas Well. We have reviewed our files and agree that the well should be reclassified and therefore present the following information to support our request for a non-standard gas prevention unit.

1. Well name and location - Grace B. Hadfield No. 1, 1900 feet from the South and East lines of Section 21, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. Description of non-standard gas prevention unit - the non-standard unit shall consist of 40 acres described as the NW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 21, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
3. The non-standard prevention unit consists of contiguous acreage in a single quarter-quarter section.
4. The non-standard gas prevention unit lies wholly within Section 21, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
5. The entire non-standard gas prevention unit, that is, the NW/4 of the SE/4 Section 21, may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
6. The length or width of the non-standard gas unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
