My letter dated August 8, 1955, from Mr. H. C. Johnson, P. O. Box 400, located that their records indicated that the above corporation was not producing from the horizontal and vertical limits of the Jalamat Pool well within the geographic and vertical limits of the Jalamat Pool, and after the gas-oil ratio exceeded 100,000 to 1, that we should make application to this office for a non-standard gas proration unit so that the well might be operated as a Jalamat gas well. We have reviewed our files and agree that the well should be reclassified and therefore present the following information to support my request for a non-standard gas proration unit.

1. Well name and location - Grace D. Hufield, located 1,000 feet from the South and East lines of Section 21, T-37-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Description of non-standard gas proration unit - The non-standard unit shall consist of 40 acres circumscribed as the NW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 21, N-37-S, T-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

3. The non-standard proration unit consists of one acreage package in a single quarter-quarter section.

4. The non-standard gas proration unit lies within Section 21, T-37-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

5. The entire non-standard gas proration unit, less than the NW/4 of the SE/4 Section 21, may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

6. The length or width of the non-standard gas proration unit exceed 5,280 feet.
