Re: Classification of Hadfield #1

Gentlemen:

On March 7, 1955 we notified you that your Hadfield #1, 21-25-37, should remain in the Langlie-Mattix pool, even though the Gas Oil Ratio exceeded 100,000 to 1. A re-examination of the records, however, indicates that this well is producing from the vertical limits of the Jalmat pool. In view of this fact, you should make application to the Director of the Commission in Santa Fe for a non-standard gas proration unit as soon as possible, so that the well may be operated as a Jalmat gas well. You should also file with this office a gas well plat in duplicate showing the acreage to be dedicated to this well.

If you have additional information which might cause you to disagree with our classification of this well, we would be glad to look into the matter further.
