2.2.2.2. *Temporary transfer of cargo*

2.2.2.2.1. *General* - The temporary transfer of cargo from one ship to another shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a) The cargo shall be transferred to the receiving ship in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Code of Practice for the Transfer of Cargo between Ships;
