MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS ON WELLS

Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After the well had been acidised with 1000 Gal and left set for 72 hours. The tubing was swabbed and the well showed approx. 48 bbls of oil and about 1 bbl. of water per 24 hrs. Showing that the acid had not improved the well.

The pressure on the casing head however, raised from 130 # to 600# showing an increase in the gas, enough to flow the well by shutting it in for 12 hours.
