DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

This well stopped flowing on or about Jan. 20th. It made 3 or 4 subsequent flows during the first week in Feb., but finally would flow no more. On Mar. 6th it was treated with 1,000 gallons of acid; on Mar. 8th the acid was unloaded; the well flowed for 12 hours, and again quit flowing. It flowed for 2 hours on Mar. 9th and 2 hours on Mar. 10, and has not been flowing since that time. The acid gave it a slight increase in gas and a slight increase in water, making approximately 50% water at the time. Derrick has been erected and we intend to set Howe pump at the 2,000 foot depth.

We expect to have this well back on production by the 22d or 23d of March, 1935.
