DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

Rotary rig to be used. To set 12 1/2 inch pipe at approximately 500 ft. Cement with 430 sacks, to shut off water found at about 475 ft. To set 9-5/8 in. seamless pipe at approximately 2850 ft., 40 or 50 ft. in the line. Cement with 450 sacks, to cement salt column. To set blow-out preventer on 9-5/8 inch casing. Drill to approximately 3200 feet, then to core ahead or test with Haliburton process as drilling proceeds until large gas pay is drilled. Circulate mud until well is killed, then set 7 inch seamless pipe approximately 3320 feet through gas pay, and cement with 125 sacks. Core and drill hole until oil pay is encountered, with total depth at approximately 3350 feet.
