Under the provisions of Commission Order No. R-520, Rule 5(b) Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, delegating the Secretary of the Commission authority to grant exceptions to the requirements of Rule 5(a) without notice and hearing for a non-standard gas provation unit, Standard Production Company applies for an exception to the rule for the Brown No. 1.

In support of the application, we present the following:

- 1. Original and two copies of the application with plat showing the proposed unit of 120 contiguous acres, consisting of the N/2 of the NW/4 and the SE/4 of the NW/4 of Section 25 Township 25 South Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Offset ownerships and the unit well, lecated 1980' from the north line and 2310' from the west line of said section 25 are shown.
- 2. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be gas productive, lies wholly within a single governmental section and is within the horizontal limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool. Neither the length or width of the proposed unit exceeds 5280'.
- 3. By copy of this application, all owners having interest in the section in which the proposed unit is situated and which acreage is not included in the unit, and all operators having interest within 1500' of the unit well have been notified by registered mail.
