By this letter application is being made for permission to flare the gas from the lease shown above until connection is made by El Paso, who has the gas contract.

The lease has two wells, the No. 1 in Unit F and the No. 2 in Unit D. It was formerly operated by A. L. Antwell and the No. 1 well has been shut in since the lease was taken over by Mr. L. F. Brown under the operating ownership of Standard Production Company. The No. 2 well was completed on January 7th, 1930, and the latest Gas Oil Ratio test shows a ratio of 4:2:1. The well is a pumping well and approximately 62 MCF were flared during the month of February.

El Paso has not connected the lease as failure to obtain right-of-way and lack of FR approval has prevented the completion of negotiations. In view of the circumstances, we shall appreciate an extension of the ninety day flaring period in order that this operator may continue to produce his oil allowable.

A plat is attached, showing offset operators and existing gas lines.
