## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

7" casing cemented at 3390 with 20 sacks. Shot 7" casing off at 3300'. Spotted cement plug at 3456' up to 3250', 40 sacks. Diameter of plug 6 1/4". Spotted cement plug in top of anhydrite at 1300' up to 1225', 25 sacks. Hole filled with heavy mud and spotted cement plug from 75' to 25', 20 sacks, and will set regulation marker to extend 4' above ground.

All cement plugs were spotted by pumping through 2" tubing.
