FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The Jack B-17 No. 3 was completed in the open hole interval 2609-3050' on 8-30-51 at a total depth of 3050' in the Yates and Seven Rivers. On 12-1-59 tubing was installed and set at 2991' and treated w/500 gals acid. This well produced 1142 MCF during the month of February 1960.

We propose to kill the well, set treating PKR at 2585', treat open hole interval 2609-3050' w/15,000 gals sandfrac with 2 lbs sand/gal in three stages using 5,000 gals with 250 gals LSTNE acid and 150 lbs rock salt between stages, run 2" TBG set at 2991' and circulate out excess sand.
