Gentlemen:

In line with your recent letter and telephone conversation of this date, we are enclosing herewith Form C-128, in duplicate, outlining acreage dedicated to the gas proration unit of our Thomas Well No. 1, in the Valmat Pool, Section 17, Township 24-S, Range 37-E.

For your information, we contacted Santa Fe, and they advised there was a shortage of 63,885 MCF as of October 31 on this well. We then contacted El Paso Natural and find that they were taking between 60 and 65,000 MCF during the month of November. Take from this the regular monthly allowable of approximately 27,000 MCF would leave a shortage of approximately 26,000 MCF to be made up during the month of December. El Paso Natural was of the opinion that the well will be zeroed during the month of December. This for your information since we discussed it on the phone. We trust this will enable you to complete your files in this matter.
