Dear Sir:

An examination of the records for your Bates #1-E in Section 18-24S-37E shows that it is producing from the Yates formation, and therefore should be placed in the Jalmat pool. The most recent Gas Oil Ratio test for this well, as reflected by Form C-116 is 101,937 to 1, which under the provisions of Order R-520, places it in the classification of a gas well. You are therefore instructed to apply to the Director of the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe for an order permitting you to operate a non-standard gas proration unit. You are further instructed to file with this office a gas well plat in duplicate showing the acreage which you wish to dedicate to this well.

This well will remain on the proration schedule in the Langlie-Mattix pool until October 1st. This should allow sufficient time for you to secure a non-standard proration unit order.
