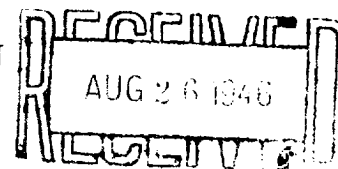

8-5/8" thirty two pound casing was cemented at 1148' with 500 sacks on August 24, 1946. Plug was pumped down at 2:30 P.M. We propose to test casing and drill plug after midnight of August 25, 1946, thus giving cement 36 hours set time.
