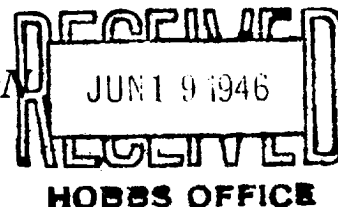

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" thirty two pound casing was cemented in an 11" hole at 1160' with 450 sacks on June 10, 1946. Cement was allowed 48 hours set time then drilled out to casing shoe and pressure tested. Test held O.K. and drilling was resumed.
