Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool of Order No. R-1670 for the formation of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of E/2 NW/4 Section 19, T-24S, R-37E, for its Jack Federal 19 Well No. 4, located 990 feet from the north line and 1587 feet from the west line of Section 19, T-24S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5(c) in all respects as follows:

- Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- 4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
