T.P. 800# In.T.P. 100#, put 10 obls. acid in formation & reversed out 10 obls. Job completed at 1:08 A.M. 9-16-49. Tbg. set at 3133' Packer set at 2983'. Well kicked off and flowed 128.76 bbls. oil in 12 hrs. on 11/64" Choke, Gas Vol. 306,000 cu. ft. per day, GOR 1188, Corrected Gravity 37.3. Well Completed.
