320' - Total Depth - Red Bed. Connected 8-5/8" O.D. Casing and tested with 1000# for 1/2 hour - Pressure did not drop. After waiting on cement 12 hours started drilling cement at 301' and drilled out to 320'. Connected 8-5/8" casing and tested cement job with 1000# for 1/2 hour. Pressure held. Started drilling formation and 7-3/8" hole at 7:25 A.M., 8-31-49.
