Re: Application to Dually
Complete Amerada Falby
No. 3, Jalmat Gas Pool

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following:

- (A) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation Falby No. 3 is located 1980' FSL and 1916' FWL of Section 19, Township 24-S, Range 37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The well was completed October 10, 1949 at a total depth of 3680'. The attached Exhibit A shows the location of this well together with the location of all offset wells.
- (B) That the subject well has 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set at 3320' and cemented with 1000 sacks cement. This well is an oil well in the Langlie-Mattix Pool producing from the open hole interval of 3320' to 3680' in the Lower Seven Rivers formation.
- (C) That the applicant proposes to produce this well dually with the Upper Seven Rivers gas through the tubing-casing annulus and the Lower Seven Rivers oil through the tubing. The attached Exhibit B is a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.
- (D) That the Upper Seven Rivers gas will be produced through the proposed perforated intervals of 3182' to 3220' and 3245' to 3278'.
- (E) That the granting of this application for permission to produce this well as a dual completion with gas from the Upper Seven Rivers and oil from the Lower Seven Rivers is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
