Re: Application of Cities Service Cil Company for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit embracing the SE/4, Sec. 19-24S-37E, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Comes now Cities Service Oil Company and respectively requests the Oil Conservation Commission to approve a non-standard gas provation unit of 160 acres, embracing the SE/4, Section 19-248-378, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support of the application wishes to state the following:

1. Cities Service Oil Company is the owner of the Thomas Lease covering the E/2, Section 19-245-372.

2. The Cities Service Thomas No. 1, located 660' from South Line, 1980' from East Line, is now classified as a Langlie-Mattix oil well. It is producing through perforations from 3025-3050', 3070-3140', 3145-3215', 3336-3346' and open hole 3351-3440', which includes the Yates and Seven Rivers formations. This well was drilled to 3663' with the Queen formation top at 3550' and then plugged back to 3440'.

3. This well meets all requirements of Rule R-520 for classification as a Jalmat gas well with a non-standard gas provation unit of 160 acres.

4. All operators having interests in Section 19-248-37E and within 1500' of the Thomas No. 1 have been notified of this application and provided with waivers to send to the Conservation Commission should they have no objection.

5. A plat is attached showing the above described lands.
