A review of the DST. data in the file reflects that the Queen is non-productive  
and thereby from the interpretation of the data it is concluded that the  
production of gas is limited to the vertical limits of the Jalmat Pool. However,  
the application should be carefully considered due to its proximity to the  
proposed Falby-Yates Pool and the 430-330' location and the effect of drainage
