Please refer to Form 9-331, filed on this well June 17, 1971, outlining the proposed procedure to convert this well to a dual injection well.

This well was deepened to 3568'. At this depth the drill string twisted off leaving one joint of 2-7/8" tubing and approximately 364' of 3 1/2" drill collars in the hole. Top of the fish is at 3173'. Efforts to recover the fish were unsuccessful.

It is now proposed to set a cement plug from approximately 3173' to 3100' and set a whipstock in an indeterminate direction at 3100' and drill to approximately 3600'. After drilling to 3600' the procedure outlined on the previous Form 9-331, filed on this well June 17, 1971, will be followed. The only change in the previously filed procedure is the setting of the cement plug and the whipstock to drill around the junk in the hole.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
