The oil zone, Langlie-Mattix (open-hole section 3180-3518') was taken into the Langlie Jack Unit, operated by Continental Oil Company. Shelly Oil Company operates the Yates Gas (perfs. 2866-3090') which was squeezed and abandoned as follows:

- 1) Moved in and rigged up workover rig 11-12-69.
- 2) Pulled Kobe tubing and pump.
- 3) Ran tubing and bit and drilled to Model D packer set at 3060'. Retrieved packer.
- 4) Set bridge plug at 3125' and Baker packer at 2750'.
- 5) Squeezed Yates perforations 2866-3090' with 200 sacks cement. WOC 24 hours.
- 6) Ran bit; drilled cement 2792-3100'. Tested casing to 600#, o.k.
- 7) Pulled bit, ran tubing and recovered bridge plug at 3125'.
- 8) Equipped oil zone to pump and returned to Langlie Jack Unit operated by Continental Oil Company.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
