Gentlemen:

This refers to our conversation with you of January 24, 1961, concerning the storage of distillate from our Jack A-21 No. 1 well, Jalmat Pool, in tanks located on our Jack A-20 Lease. As pointed out in our conversation with you, the Jack A-20 oil wells no longer are capable of oil production and we desire to store the Jack A-21 distillate in these tanks.

Attached for your approval is our C-110 which will authorize this storage. Also attached are two copies of a letter received from the U.S.G.S. which states they have no objection to this storage since both leases are on the same Federal lease.
