FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Original total depth, 3484'. 15 1/2" casing @ 147 set mud; 6 5/8" casing @ 1450 w/328 sx; 6 5/8" casing @ 3219' w/324 sx; and 2 1/2" tubing @ 3410'.

Permission is hereby requested to re-complete as gas well as follows: Conduct radioactive survey of well-bore; Set bridging-plug @ approximate depth of 3090'; spot two sacks of Cal-seal on top of bridging-plug; Jet-perforate the 6 5/8" casing from 3020' - 3070' using four shots (8 holes) per foot; installation of 2 1/2" tubing to depth of 3075'; chemically treat with 500 gallons of 15% acid, swab and test gas volume.

The present 2 1/2" tubing will be pulled by Shell Oil Company before operations by El Paso Natural Gas Company commence.

Notification of transfer of ownership of the well by Shell Oil Company to El Paso Natural Gas Company will be forthcoming.
