DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 12, 1952 ran 115 jts. & 14.75 piece jt. 3786.37' of 9-5/8" 36# SS casing. Set and cemented at 3800' w/1050 sacks cement, 950 sacks 4% Gel & 100 sacks neat on bottom. Plug at 3731'. Maximum pressure 800#. Completed at 1:00 PM 7-12-52. Gulf temperature survey in 6 hrs showed top cement at 1970'.

After waiting over 48 hrs tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled plug and tested cement w/500# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
