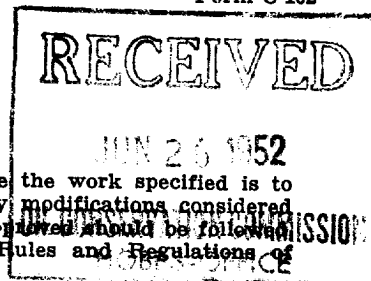

On June 25, 1952 ran 10 joints 303.64' of 13-3/8" OD 61# 8 rnd thd. J-55 ss casing w/ST&C and Baker Guide shoe. Set and cemented at 319' w/375 sacks Neat Longhorn bulk cement. Plug at 300'. Maximum pressure 200#. Circulated approximately 25 sacks cement. Completed 3:00 AM 6-25-52.

Propose to drill plug and test casing shut-off 3:00 AM 6-26-52.
