DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 22, 1953, treated formation thru 2-3/8" tubing and 7" casing perforations at 10,220-10,010' with 2000 gallons 15% NE acid by Cardinal Chemical Company. Average injection rate 84 gallons per minute. TP 2700-1800#. CP 1100#. Flushed with 47 barrels of oil.

RESULTS: Swabbed 30 barrels of oil and 36 barrels of acid water in 4 hours. Well kicked off and flowed 156 barrels of oil and 11 barrels of acid water in 9 hours.


