Elevation 3181'. TD 3595'. Casing in hole: 8-5/8"-1270'-100 sax; 7"-3300'-set on shoulder with 8 1/4 x 7" packer. Ran 3500' 2 1/2" tubing. Installed pumping equipment. Pulled rods and tubing, moved off pumping equipment. Placed swage and valve in top of 7" casing. Shut well in, temporarily abandoned. We propose to maintain this well in a temporarily abandoned status with the expectation of a waterflood some time in the future.
