FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This is a wildcat well, with no oil or gas showings except a very light smell of gas at 3060'. There is no bottom hole water. Total depth 3702', measured by Halliburton. WE will plug back from 3702' to 1450' with mud and then use 20 sacks of cement for a plug. Will then try to pull what 8" pipe we can get, then plug back to the next water sand at 1168' then cement with 10 sacks of cement, then mud back to the surface water at 138' and plug with 10 sacks of cement. The surface water is shut off with the surface casing as that will have to be set in, as I do not believe it can be pulled. Will then fill up cellar and pit, and mark exact location of abandoned well with a steel marker 4" in diameter set in cement extending 4' above ground level.

ANALYTICAL CHEMISTRY
