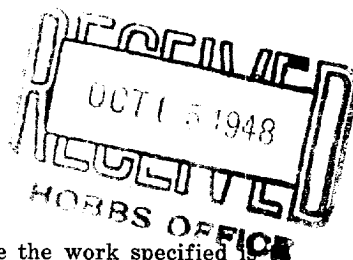

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Inasmuch as no oil was encountered in this well at a total depth of <sup>360'</sup>~~1100'~~, we propose to plug and abandon as follows:

A 10 sack cement plug will be placed on bottom; hole will be filled with mud to top of salt which is at 1100'; a 10 sack cement plug will be placed at this point. Hole will be filled with drilling mud to 360' and cement plug to top. A 4" pipe marker will be left in hole.

This well was spudded 8-29-48 at 2:00 A. M. 7 5/8" casing was set at 413' and cemented with 150 sacks cement on 8-30-48, plug was down at 11:00 A. M., cement came to surface. After letting cement set for 24 hours, 1000# pressure was applied to casing and after 30 minutes, no drop in pressure was noted. Drilling was resumed.
