

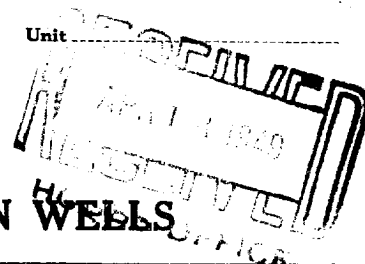

DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to set 3260' - 5 1/2" - 14 lb. casing, to be cemented with 425 sacks with 5' 2' annular.
Total depth is 3475'. Hole size 7 7/8". A Baker triplex shoe will be run on the bottom of the casing to divert the cement upward and a Baker float collar will be run on the first joint above the triplex shoe. 700 72 hrs. before testing casing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
