Please advise as to your plans for each of the above wells, along with the time frame in which these plans are to be executed. This notification should be made on Form C-103 for state and fee wells; for federal wells, Form 9-331 should be submitted to the Minerals Management Service with a copy to this office.

The Division has set a few general guidelines as to what proposed plans will be acceptable. They are as follows:

1. Return well to production
2. Workover of well
3. Plug and abandonment of well
4. Request to Division Director for extension of temporarily abandoned status

This information should be submitted to the District I office of the OCD by September, 15, 1982.
