DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth 3492', Killed well with 140 Bbl Oil, Rigged up Unit (Cardwell), Pulled Tubing and shot well with 150 Qts Nitroglycerin from 3380' to 3480' Packed with 1 Yard Pea Gravel, Shot went off at 4:54PM 10-16-43, went in hole with tools and found top of Cavings at 3400'. Cleaned out to Bottom October 25th and ran 2 1/2" Tubing back to 3471' and swabbed 5 hrs and well started flowing into tanks.

Before Shot, October 5th., 1943, well flowed 24 hrs 14/64" Choke made 13.37 Bbls Oil
Casing Pressure 250# Tubing Pressure 100#.

After Shot, October 26th., 1943, well flowed 24 hrs 16/64" Choke made 65.52 Bbls Oil
Casing Pressure 275# Tubing Pressure 170#
