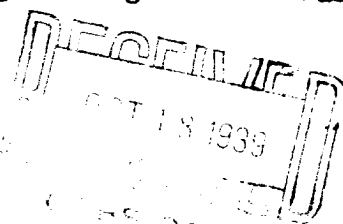

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Seamless casing set @ 3266' and cemented with 200 sacks of cement, pump pressure of 1200# was applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed, and the pressure within observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied. Again there was no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed 10/11/39.
