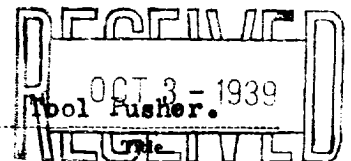
DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

@ TD 455'. 8 5/8" OD seamless casing was set @ 447' and cemented with 140 sacks of common cement, on September 22, 1939.

The well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 48 hours. The cement plug was then drilled and the hole bailed dry. Operations were suspended for a period of 1 hour. The bailer was again run to determine if water had accumulated. There was no water present.

Drilling was resumed on the evening of September 24, 1939.
