FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

It is our intention to pull 2" tubing and perforate the Yates sand through 7" casing from 2990' to 3030' with two shots per foot, after which tubing will be re-run with packer set near the bottom of the 7" casing. This proposed work will be done under pressure, using Otis Pressure Control, Inc., in order to prevent the necessity of killing well, which might prove detrimental. The purpose for a dual completion of this well is to secure necessary gas for the gas lifting of our L. Woolworth Lease Wells No. 1, 2, and 3. The gas, after being used for gas lifting purposes, will be delivered to a natural gas pipe line for public consumption. At the present time, well is producing approximately 15 barrels of oil per day.

After job has been completed, gas will be produced from the annulus through the casinghead and oil will be produced through the 2" tubing.

Please be advised application for special exception to PAO No. 11 has been made to the Federal Government and approval has been obtained and case No. G-772 has been assigned.
