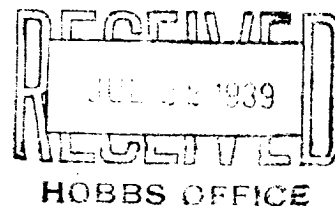

8-5/8" O.D. Seamless 32# casing had been set at 1470 feet and cemented with 100 sacks of cement, using Haliburton process. The plug was drilled on June 2nd, and after a good test the well was entirely dry and in first class condition.
