DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On September 28th the well was plugged back from 3577 to 3557 (20 foot plug) with steel cuttings and lead wool, and an additional 10 feet of gravel was tamped on top of the metal plug, the sole purpose of this plug being a safe guard against the intrusion of water. On Sept. 29th the well was shot with 380 quarts of ~~XN~~ liquid glycerin between the depths of 3464 and 3546. The hole was full of oil to the top of the 7" casing when the shot was fired. The casing point of the 7" oil string was at 3242. The contractor shooting the well was the Independent Eastern Torpedo Co. After the shot the hole cleaned itself in a few minutes by flowing into the slush pit. Immediately after the
