DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 23rd 3238 feet of new 7"-24# seamless casing was run, the casing being set at a depth of 3242 feet and cemented by pump and plug method with 150 sacks of cement. On August 26 work was started in drilling the plug, and on August 27 at a depth of 3255 the water shut-off test was made by bailing the hole dry and letting it set for 30 minutes. The water shut-off was complete.
